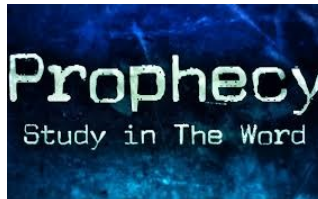
Computer Classes

Financial responsibility and being prudent with our government's resources have been part of my mission as Chief since Day One. I am so proud to relay that a valued member of my Cabinet has been selected for excellence in the field of fiscal management.

Recently, Cherokee Nation Treasurer Lacey Horn was named "Executive of the Year" by the Native American Finance Officers Association for innovative planning and forecasting of Cherokee Nation finances.

This is a well-deserved honor for our tribal treasurer, who is a vital part of our administration.

Lacey oversees the finances for the Cherokee Nation, which includes our \$696.3 million budget and 3,500 employees in 22 departments. During her tenure, we have received clean audits, earned national financial awards and had our credit rating upgraded.

Additionally, the treasurer has done all of this invaluable work for the Cherokee people during an exceptionally challenging time for tribes with the federal sequestration crippling many of the programs most essential to Native people. Lacey is not only an asset to the Cherokee tribal government, but she is also a role model for all Cherokee women who have a passion for public service.

The association that made the award presentation commended our efforts on a program that will save more than \$7 million on the tribe's self-insured health plan. This creative effort involved input from the tribe's finance, human resources and contract health services departments to devise a transition into a Medicare-like rate program for our people. Other forward thinking financial initiatives include moving the tribe's unemployment insurance from the state to Cherokee Nation and negotiating bank pricing on prepaid debit cards.

Lacey has literally saved our tribal government millions of dollars. Those dollars are being used to provide more services, build more homes, educate more students and create more jobs.

Good governance means quality ideas and decisive actions that will have a positive ripple effect for years. As Chief of the Cherokee Nation, I am indebted to talented people like Lacey who are committed to advancing the Cherokee Nation and its people.
